## Call for applications 2020

Open Call 1"Support of multilingual projects in five countries"

Announcement date: 23.12.2020

Regional Network for Cultural Diversity - READ is regional EU funded project, with aim to enable civil society actors to foster and contribute to intercultural tolerance and democratic values with particular focus on youth. The Project is implemented by Goethe-Institut Skopje together with its partner organizations: Association Krokodil (Serbia), Center for Balkan Cooperation- Loja (North Macedonia), Instituti I Librit dhe i Promocionit (Albania), Kalem Culture Association (Turkey) and Qendra Multimedia (Kosovo).

The project started on 01st of September, 2020 and will last till 31th of August, 2024. The available sub-grants budget is €80.000 in total for three rounds of calls in three years. For the first round of the Call, available budget is €28.000.

The <u>Open Call 1 "Support of multilingual projects in five countries"</u> aims to support the regional diffusion of literary works from target countries. The purpose of this effort is expected to be for translation, in combination with presentation and promotion of regional literature. The support from this project will supplement and significantly scale-up the interregional translation of authors from Western Balkan and Turkey.

Deadline for applying: 10th February, 2021, till 00:00 at local time

The maximum amount of support for this call is 2.000€ per grant.

Support of multilingual projects means awarding 12-15 small grants to CSOs from Albania, Kosovo, North Macedonia, Serbia and Turkey (the target is approximately 2-3 sub-grants per country). The Action should cover costs related to translation, design and print, and promotion of regional literature.

Original works from eligible countries in the call should be translated in other languages from the eligible countries in the call (for ex. A turkish author should be translated in Albanian, Serbian or Macedonian language).

All applications must be submitted electronically via the Goethe Application Portal-GAP in English language: <a href="https://kulturfoerderung.goethe.de/r.aspx?q=Ct9PbAFZ">https://kulturfoerderung.goethe.de/r.aspx?q=Ct9PbAFZ</a>, with possibility to fulfill detailed description of the Project in local language – Albanian, Serbian, Macedonian or Turkish. All necessary documents for this call can be found on the GAP portal.

The applicants need to be:

- non-profit making;
- civil society organizations;
- directly responsible for the preparation and management of the project with co-applicant(s);
- registered in Albania, Kosovo, North Macedonia, Serbia or Turkey for at least 6 months before the date of publication of the call;
- working on one or more of the thematic areas of relevance of this Call for Proposals

















Only one application from each applicant will be considered.
